

## Ice/Snow – Gritting Rota 2021/22

It takes 2/3 people, 10/20 mins to grit each hill using shovels/wheelbarrows. Obviously, it only takes one person to "inspect" the hills before deciding to call out other group members. I have divided "volunteers" into 4 groups and nominated the person responsible for inspecting the hills in the rota below. Each week starts on a Sunday evening. **If you cannot do the inspection please swap with or ask someone in your group to do it for you.**

**Ice/light snow** - It makes most sense to grit the hills the evening (6/8 pm) before (black) ice or snow is forecast. Please bear in mind that an **ICY** hill is just as dangerous and needs gritting.

**Major Snowfall** - If a significant overnight snowfall is forecast on a working day, I suggest everyone who wants to get to work/school gather at the pond at **6.45/7.00am** to clear the hill(s).
